Dear Parents/Carers

Arrangements for Years 1 and 2

Firstly thank you for your patience and understanding as we have managed the unprecedented flooding issues within school. I am pleased to confirm that school will reopen to Years 1 and 2 from tomorrow, Thursday 7th June.

The drying and cleaning of the classrooms was completed by contractors, but unfortunately moisture has returned through the walls. We have therefore agreed with KCC and the contractors to remove all carpet and fully dry the rooms before they are brought back into use. This is expected to take a minimum of 3 weeks, meaning that alternative classrooms are required to accommodate the affected classes.

For the remainder of this week, pupils will be accommodated within other parts of the school buildings, including the hall, which has had replacement flooring fitted and the small hall and ICT room. Teachers will work creatively during these two days to ensure this is a fun and productive learning environment for the children.

Please note the following arrangements for dropping off and picking up of all Year 1 and 2 children:-

Morning (Drop off): All Year 1 and 2 children should enter the school via Year 3 and 4 entrance
Afternoon (Collection): All Year 1 and 2 children should be collected from the Infant Playground (Bottom Playground)

From Monday 11th June, pupils will be dropped off and picked up from school at the normal times, but then transported by coach to Wouldham All Saints Primary School. We are fortunate that Wouldham has recently expanded, but currently has spare classrooms available. We are very grateful to the Headteacher and staff of Wouldham All Saints for warmly welcoming Tunbury to their new school. We will post some photographs of the Wouldham All Saints school on the Tunbury website, so that you can see where your children will be taught for the next few weeks. This arrangement will remain in place until the end of June initially and further information will be provided nearer to that time.

We are confident that this is the best way forward to provide your children with a suitable and safe learning environment as quickly as possible. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your class teacher or a member of the Senior Leadership Team who will be happy to discuss this with you.
